

Other useful information

- If any refuse or recyclables are placed out before 6pm the evening before collection is due (ie 6pm Monday if your collection is Tuesday) will be treated as abandoned refuse and the person responsible may face a £50 fixed penalty notice or a prosecution which can lead to a fine of up to £2,500.
- Please avoid using black sacks for recycling as they can easily be mistaken for refuse. Also, it is very difficult to sort recycling from such a large flimsy container. The sacks will not be collected on recycling days. If you would like extra bumper boxes (£2), Red Bags (£1), as well as lids (£1.20) they are available from the main reception at Carrick House, Pydar Street, Truro and Carrick's One Stop Shop, Church Street, Falmouth, or from the Cashier's office, The Moor, Falmouth. If using bins for surplus recycling please put glass alone in your bumper box and mixed cans and plastic bottles in the bin.
- Householders can take their waste to the civic amenity site at United Downs (near St Day). For opening times and information please telephone 01209 820659.

Garden Waste Collection

WHAT is it?

An easy & convenient way to get rid of lawnmowings, prunings etc outside of your garden gate. It's delivered to local farmers who are paid to compost it into soil conditioner for their fields.

HOW do I use the service?

Put your garden waste into a prepaid **blue** Carrick sack. Put this on the kerbside outside of your home on garden waste collection day.

WHEN is it collected?

Every fortnight. Look for the **blue** dates on the enclosed calendar. Collections are still made on Bank Holidays. Make sure sacks are out by 7am to guarantee collection. **Blue** sacks will be collected only on blue collection days. They will be left for the next **blue** day if put out on dustbin day.

WHAT can I put in the blue sacks?

Can I put out my garden waste in a different sack or container?

NO. We will collect it only if it is in an official Carrick **blue** sack. Dustbins or rubbish bags containing any garden waste will not be emptied/collected on dustbin day.

Garden waste composted on local farms, average/month:
NOW 356 tonnes (increased from 300 tonnes) - Keep it UP!
